According to the American Cancer Society, survival rates for cancer in young adults have not changed much in recent decades, unlike the improvements seen in many cancers in children and older adults. Ironically, this is the same demographic that has the greatest need for financial assistance, a need noted by David “Pooh” Maddan when he was fighting his own battle with cancer. The David Andrew “Pooh” Maddan Foundation, a/k/a DAM-CANCER, a non-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization, was established to honor and celebrate Dave’s life, which was cut much too short as a result of complications, related to the treatment, of osteosarcoma (cancer of the bone).

Pooh died unexpectedly at the age of 28 on October 25, 2008 from complications related to his cancer treatments. Dave was passionate about establishing a non-profit Foundation to assist other young adult cancer patients (ages 18 through 35) as soon as he completed his own treatments. This Foundation is dedicated to realizing Pooh’s dream and to keeping his memory and legacy alive.

Of all cancer age groups, young adults are the most financially vulnerable. More specifically, these are the young persons who may have recently graduated from high school or college, who haven’t been in the working world long enough to have funds to get them through the economic disaster of cancer, and whose families may not be able to provide sufficient financial assistance. These young adults are the cancer patients the Foundation has targeted for grants for living expenses, medical treatments and medicines not covered by insurance, transportation to treatments, medical co-pays, food, temporary housing, utilities, etc. DAM-CANCER has made more than 540 grants for living expenses to recipients throughout the United States. Applications continue to pour in because the need is so great for these young adults battling cancer.

We invite you to come golf for Pooh! 100% of the proceeds from the golf tournament and dinner go directly to our young adult recipients to provide them the support they need so they may focus on their fight.
